



The **2017 Paloma Cabernet Sauvignon** shares multiple layers of dark fruit, anise, and rich tones of cocoa. The alluring aromas are followed by a rich, silky mouthfeel with subtle notes of pomegranate. This beautiful expression of Spring Mountain fruit offers immediate enjoyment and promises continued pleasure. Enjoy this offering with a sumptuous meal of barbecue pork and crème brûlée for dessert.

The 2017 is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. It is fermented and then aged in French oak—33% new—for 18 months before being bottled in the spring and bottle-aged for an additional 30 months.

In 2003, Paloma Vineyard's 2001 Merlot was chosen by the Wine Spectator as the Wine of the Year out of over 15,000 wines from around the world. Since 2003, Paloma Merlot has been in the Wine Spectator TOP 100 two more times—in 2004 for the 2002 vintage (54<sup>th</sup>) and in 2009 for the 2006 vintage (65<sup>th</sup>)—as well as received the Wine Spectator Special Selection in 2012 for the 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon. Paloma Vineyard uses only estate fruit that is picked, fermented, and barreled in small lots.
